
The Summer Solstice, the longest day of the year, is a time of ABUNDANCE. We are so happy to share some of what we've been up to during our first season!







### SOIL

We are so grateful to be working with BEAUTIFUL SOIL -- dark, rich, nutritious, moisture-retaining and alive with microorganisms. We are using silage tarps which stop weed growth without interfering with biological life. When we pull back the tarps after a month or two, we only need to do a quick rake before planting!







### FIRST HARVEST

What a celebratory day! We delivered our very first harvest back to our ROOTS IN BOSTON. First stop was dear friends at Fresh Food Generation, where Siedric was the founding chef.
